Caring Science Executive Leadership Intensive

For Chief Nursing Officers & Senior Nurse Leaders

Executive nurse leaders are asked to translate the mission, vision, and values of their organization and set the tone and culture for the entire nursing team, all while managing tremendous and ever-increasing complexity. Meeting this moment requires intentionality along with a human-centered approach and focus. It is more important than ever for senior nurse executives to invest in their own leadership practice.



The Caring Science Executive Leadership Intensive provides structure and space for senior nurse leaders to refocus and reflect on their values and sense of purpose so that they can show up fully and with authenticity in their leadership. Designed by Dr. Jean Watson and the Watson Caring Science Institute (WSCI), this program will equip leaders with tools and practical strategies for supporting a culture of caring and relationship-centered healthcare.

Program structure: Participants will meet via Zoom every other Wednesday at 12 noon EST, for one or two hours (alternating) from March 1st - May 17th, 2023.

Caring Science Executive Leadership Intensive participants will:

- Reflect on how their personal journey informs their executive leadership strengths and how intentional shifts can enhance authentic presence
- Connect with and learn from fellow executive nurse leaders with a shared sense of purpose
- Explore ways of 'being-in-right-relation' with themselves, colleagues, patients, families, and their organizations
- Intellectually and experientially explore Caring Science as a relationship-based approach to care and leadership

Utilizing Watson's Caring Science as a practice model has been shown to reduce staff turnover significantly as well as increase patients' perception of caring.
