## **Leadership in Turbulent Times**

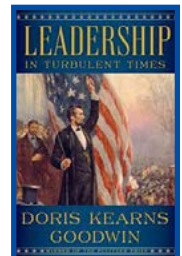

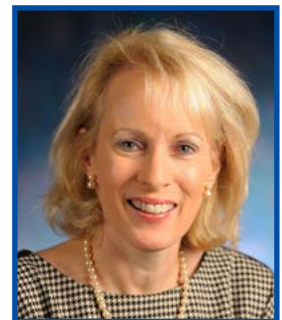
