KEYNOTE SPEAKER

**Tim Porter O'Grady,
DM, EdD, ScD(h), APRN, FAAN, FACCWS**

Dr. Tim Porter-O'Grady is well-recognized as an expert in clinical health systems, nursing leadership, professional governance, and health systems innovation. He has been a nurse for over 50 years, is an advanced practice nurse, is board certified in geriatrics and wound specialties, and holds two earned doctorates, one in learning behavior and another in complex systems leadership. He currently leads an international health consulting practice and is a clinical professor at the Emory University School of Nursing.



Effective nurse leadership is mission-critical, impacting nursing professionals' opportunity to make high-value nursing contributions, thereby impacting patient outcomes, job satisfaction, and retention. However, the leadership capacity needed to meet the present moment in nursing differ greatly from the prevailing leadership models built on industrial-grounded research and theories—models that are no longer relevant to advancing professional practice nor to present times.

Dr. Porter O'Grady will explore what real-world contemporary leadership looks like in a Professional Governance model, explain how it differs from predominant leadership models, and share three leadership skill-sets that best empower nursing professionals to advance nursing strategic objectives, deliver high-impact nursing contributions, and meet their own professional aims. Participants are encouraged to bring their own questions, challenges, and insights in support of a robust dialogue directed to deepening, clarifying and validating desired leadership approaches transforming nursing leadership and practice behaviors.
